	<p>Dr PA – There's been a lot of discussions on strikes and pay.</p> <p>Low amount of exception reports.</p> <p>Still have a number of exception reports pending an outcome with discussions ongoing from Public Health colleagues in training.</p> <p>Dr PA advised that the BMA are suggesting you don't have to report if you haven't done any work during a non-resident on call shift but for the guardian of safe working, this makes it impossible to work out average working hours. Dr PA pointed out that this information would still be required in order to calculate average hours worked. Dr PA is in discussions with the BMA on whether that is good advice and is comfortable to make changes/change rotas & increase resident doctors average working hours but requires the information to be able to do it, how this is captured is still under discussion.</p>	N/A	N/A
